Do you go to the grocery store with your mother? Do you help her carry the bags of food? I'm sure she appreciates your help.

The children in this picture live in a rural community in Guatemala, a long way from where we live. They went to get food with their mothers, but they don't have grocery stores like we do, and they didn't ride in a car. They had to walk many miles because last fall there were two hurricanes within ten days that washed out many roads and caused major flooding in their country. They met someone who brought them food so they would have something to eat. La Mision, an agency in Guatemala that receives some of our Dimes, sent food to some of

the villages that were isolated by the hurricane. La Mision included formula so this baby would have healthy food to help her grow.

When we share our dimes, we can help our neighbors far away who are hungry.
